

LEED Green Associates Prep Class

Come join us for a one day LEED GA prep class. Students will learn about the LEED rating system developed by the US. Green Building Council. The one day class will explore green building techniques and LEED core concepts. The class will also provide study strategies for taking and passing the LEED GA exam. Each student will be provided with a study guide and practice exam. Abe Kruger with Kruger Sustainability Group and Anj McClain with greenlspaces will be teaching the one day class.

The Green Associates Prep Class is geared toward a variety of professionals who are planning to earn the LEED Green Associates credential. Beginning this exam is the first step toward pursuing a deeper understanding of the various LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) rating system and becoming a LEED Accredited Professional in an area of expertise such as operations and maintenance or neighborhood development.



The Green Associates credential is administered by the GBCI (Green Building Certification Institute) and is designed for professionals who want to demonstrate green building expertise in non-technical fields of practice. The Green Associates credential denotes basic knowledge of green design, construction, and operations.
